

- Develop a coherent and inclusive AO TESA research strategy in close collaboration with the global AO Trauma Research Commission
- Promotion and further development of the AO TESA Stephan Perren Research Fellowship initiative
- Introduce innovative programs and activities to attract clinicians and researchers to AO TESA
- Collaborate with AO TESA Community Development Committee to support programs
- Collaborate with AO TESA Education Committee to ensure evidence-based information is fed into education programs
- Cultivate mutually beneficial partnerships with academic societies and research bodies
- Ensure the AO Trauma brand is correctly presented on all research materials and at relevant events
- Ensure collaboration with other AO Clinical Divisions, local AO bodies, and approved industrial partners
- Accountable to the AO Trauma Research Commission
- Represent the interests of AO TESA on the global AO Trauma Research Commission
- Support projects initiated by the global AO Trauma Research Commission

- Provide regular research reports (with the support AO Trauma Europe and Southern Africa Regional Director) to the AO TESA Board

- Strong reputation and well published (>15 publications) in high impact journals

- First rate research network and connections including fund raising capabilities
- Experience in multi-center clinical or basic research studies
- Highly motivated to build and manage research programs for all member groups
- Clear communicator and good listener with the ability to work in multi-cultural environments
- Prepared to commit at least 1–2 days per month to AO TESA governance and administration
- Very good command of English
- Ability to communicate with others in a respectful and tactful way that respects cultural, social, academic, and economic differences
- Recognized member of key national, regional, or international orthopedic trauma associations
